Program Description: Augmentative Communication group: The focus of this group is on using devices to appropriately gain attention, request and comment in a group setting. The group gives the children the opportunities to communicate with adults as well as with other children using devices. Parents will have the opportunity to meet other parents whose children are AAC users. This group is lead by two speech-language pathologists. Additional volunteers and graduate students/interns also participate in groups for additional support. There is a maximum of 6 children in the group. The AAC group is a 1.5 hour group and runs one time per week for 12 weeks. For participation in this group, the child must use an AAC device as his/her functional communication system. It is required that the child have a current speech language evaluation.
